

Twin Cities Area Transportation Authority Request for Quotes for Passenger Shelters and Benches

Twin Cities Area Transportation Authority (TCATA), located at 275 East Wall Street, Benton Harbor, Michigan 49022, is a public transit agency and is seeking quotes for up to three passenger shelters (two (2) single & one (1) double with benches included) and up to three (3) additional benches. Award will be to the low quote from a responsive and responsible firm.

Quotes are due by 2:00 pm EST, on Friday, January 16, 2019, at the TCATA office at 275 East Wall Street, Benton Harbor, MI 49022, Attn: Alex Little, Executive Director, or by email to tcata.alex@comcast.net. Quotes must be submitted on the attached Quote Form and remain valid for 90 days.

TCATA reserves the right to postpone the due date or to reject any or all quotes for sound, documentable, business reasons. TCATA is exempt from Federal, State, and local taxes and taxes will not be included in the quote. All delivery charges must be included in the quote with delivery to TCATA's office. All products must be new and have a one-year warranty.

II. SPECIFICATIONS/SCOPE OF WORK

A. General Description, Quantity, Dimensions

The three (3) bus shelters (two (2) single & one (1) double with benches included) and up to three (3) individual benches must be prefabricated in four (4) or more modular sections complete and ready for field installation. All connections and glazing shall be tamper proof.

The size of the single shelter shall be 10' in length by 5' in depth. Height shall be no lower than 7' 6" to top of fascia and no higher than 8' to top of fascia. Size of the double shelter shall be 20' in length by 5' in depth. Height shall be no lower than 7' 6" to top of fascia and no higher than 8' to top of fascia.

Quotes must include:

- Color shall be white translucent. Roof shall be serviceable without removing fascia, and shall be leak proof.
- Structural aluminum frame with Powder coat finish (instead of anodized)
- An all aluminum roof
- Translucent hip roof
- Scratch-free/scratch resistant safety glass
- Solar powered LED lighting for the shelter
- Mounted trash can with bronze anodized finish
- Map display case

- All freight and delivery charges to TCATA, 275 East Wall Street, Benton Harbor, MI
- Bench seat of similar aluminum materials and finish
 - Bench shall run the length of the shelter, allowing sufficient space for one wheelchair, in accordance with requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and shall be designed to be anchored to the concrete. All anchor assembly hardware shall be provided.
- All required hardware and installation instructions
 - All shelters and benches shall be provided with all parts, materials, hardware, glazing, roof, anchor shoes, fasteners and any other components necessary for completeness and installation even though such parts, materials, or details may not be mentioned in these specifications.

TCATA is also seeking to be able to acquire up to two additional of any of the units quoted as described at the quoted unit price if the item is ordered within 120 days of the bid award.

B. Additional Standards

All aluminum shall conform to the standards of the Aluminum Association. All glazing shall conform to the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) Safety Standards for Architectural Glazing Materials Z97.1-1975. Shelters shall be designed to withstand minimum vertical and horizontal windload of 20 PSF. Roofs shall be designed to withstand minimum deadload of 40 PSF.

Shelters and benches shall be constructed of modular interchangeable components. All structural framing members shall be one-piece seamless extruded aluminum tubes. Snap together two-piece members are not acceptable.

C. Description of Products

The products offered must be in compliance with the specifications included in this RFQ. Quotes shall include a complete and detailed description of the product offered with sufficient information demonstrating that the product meets the specifications. Product literature, drawings, and/or photographs shall be provided to illustrate the general design of the product and its components.
